BLACK, OOLONG, AND PU' ERH TEAS

- 1) Ancient Forest Black Tea (Kosher Organic) The most alluring aspect of this tea is the deeply penetrating flavor and aroma that it imparts, which is unlike any other black or green tea on the market. Bold, dark, and inviting; this tea is partially fermented which will appeal to the senses of both the black tea lover and the green tea lover. (MR)

- 2) Assam Tea BOP (Organic) - Broken Leaf Orange Pekoe (BOP) from the Assam Valley, India is the quintessential black Indian tea. This small leaf black tea has a delicious malty taste and consistently delivers a medium-bodied flavor. Ideal for a breakfast tea. Rich, robust, astringent and highly aromatic. (SW)

- 3) Assam T.G.F.O.P (Organic Fair Trade)- Assam Black Tea from the mountains of southern India. Being T.G.F.O.P , it contains many lighter golden tan tips of the tea adding more depth of taste. Characters: full body flavor, rich malty flavor. (SW) Coming soon

- 4) Assam Tea HOP (Organic Faire Trade) - High Grown Orange Pekoe from the Assam Valley, is the quintessential black Indian tea. Rich, robust, astringent and highly aromatic. (F)

- 5) Blackberry Flavored Black Tea (Organic)- A premium organic black tea flavored with sweet organic blackberry leaves and natural blackberry flavor. Ingredients: Organic black Tea, Organic Blackberry leaves, and natural Blackberry flavor.

- 6) Black Current flavored Black Tea (Organic) Organic Black tea flavored with organic blackberry leaves and natural black currant flavor. Deliciously smooth and sweet in flavor. (SW)

- 7) Ceylon Tea H.O.P (Organic Faire Trade) – Black Camellia sinensis from Sri Lanka (formerly Colony of Ceylon). An excellent tea for afternoon sipping. Has a bright flavor and a little less robust than an Assam Black Tea. Characters: Slightly dry, woody, citrusy, and light body. (F)

- 8) Ceylon Tea B.O.P. – Black Camellia sinensis from Sri Lanka (formerly Colony of Ceylon). An afternoon tea that provides a bright flavor with mellow astringency and less robust flavor than Assam black tea. Characters: Slightly dry, woody, citrusy, and light body. Put a new

twist on tea by serving Ceylon with a slice of orange, instead of lemon. You'll marvel at how well the flavor and aromas meld and support each other. Highly versatile, Ceylon goes well with all the traditional foods of tea time. (S)

- 9) Chai Tea, Black (Organic Faire Trade) . A blend of Assam and South Indian black teas with spices. There are many favorite recipes for chai, but the spices most often included are cinnamon, cardamom, cloves, ginger and black pepper. Characters: spicy, aromatic, and full body. (F)

- 10) China Black Tea (Organic OP) - Camellia sinensis from China. A well-rounded, robust and flavorful tea brew that is good as a breakfast tea or as a base for making your own flavored teas. Characters: spicy, bright, slight citrus and medium body. (F)

- 11) China Black Tea (Organic BOP) - Camellia sinensis (Orange Pekoe) from China. A well-rounded, robust and flavorful tea brew that is good as a breakfast tea or as a base for making your own flavored teas. Characters: spicy, bright, slight citrus, and medium body. (SW)

- 12) China Black Tea (Organic FOP) - Camellia sinensis (Orange Pekoe) from China. A well-rounded, robust and flavorful tea brew that is good as a breakfast tea or as a base for making your own flavored teas. Characters: spicy, bright, slight citrus, and medium body. (SW) Coming soon

- 13) Classic Chai (Organic Faire Trade) A great alternative for those who wish to avoid large amounts of caffeine, sugar, and dairy products, which are commonly found in commercial Chai products. An exotic beverage that is sure to tickle your taste buds! Organic Ginger root, organic and fair trade Cinnamon bark, organic and fair trade Darjeeling Tea, organic Cardamom, organic and fair trade Cloves, and organic and fair trade Nutmeg. Contains Caffeine. (MR)

- 14) Cranberry Orange Flavored Black Tea (Organic) Indian Assam tea blended with a bountiful mélange of cranberry flavor and bits of real orange. Subtly sweet and delicious brew. Characters: robust, tea like with mild cranberry notes, and medium body. (F)

- 15) Darjeeling Tea (Organic Faire Trade) - Camellia sinensis from India. Regarded as the champagne of black teas, this complex, very flavorful and aromatic tea is ideal for afternoon tea. Characters: Smooth & elegant, bright, slightly dry, and light body. (F)

- 16) Earl Grey Tea (Organic Faire Trade) Earl Grey Tea combines the smoky taste of black tea and organic bergamot oil for a delicate, aromatic beverage. A blend of Irish Breakfast Tea and Bergamot oil.
- 17) Earl Grey Tea Decaffeinated (Organic Faire Trade) Earl Grey Tea combines the smoky taste of black tea and organic bergamot oil for a delicate, aromatic beverage. A blend of decaffeinated Black Tea and Bergamot oil.
- 18) Earl Grey With Cacao (Organic ingredients but not certified) This Earl Grey Tea combines the smoky taste of Irish Breakfast tea, organic bergamot oil, and cacao nibs for a delicate, aromatic beverage. (HB)
- 19) English Breakfast Tea (Organic Faire Trade) English Breakfast is a tea hearty enough to pair with a full breakfast or a tea-time repast of freshly baked scones. (F)
- 20) Irish Breakfast Tea(Organic Faire Trade) - Rustic and warm with a comfortable solid flavor and aroma, Irish Breakfast is a familiar and satisfying favorite. (F)
- 21) Keemun Congou (FOP Organic) Keemun is considered one of the best Organic China Black Teas. Due to its superb bouquet, this particular black tea is often referred to as the “burgundy of teas”. Full-bodied, sweet liquoring tea producing a dark red cup of infused tea. Is a high quality long leaf tea with a few tips. Great hot or cold (SW)
- 22) Kukicha Twig Tea (Organic Faire Trade) - Consisting primarily of leaf stems and fine tea twigs, this low-caffeine tea produces a mild, woody-malty brew. Unlike leaf teas, kukicha is best prepared by simmering for 10 minutes. (F)
- 23) Lapsang Souchong Tea (Organic) - A smoked tea with a robust, roasted aroma and flavor, a cup of Lapsang Souchong. (F)
- 24) Lychee Flavored Black Tea- Lychee Black Tea is made from black tea which has been scented with the essence of lychee, a sweet tropical fruit. This tea has a natural, sweet, and very aromatic character. When brewed, the tea has a reddish brown hue and a light sweet honey-like taste. (SW)

- 25) Mango Ceylon(Organic Faire Trade- The smooth flavor of Organic Black Tea and organic mango flavor along with elegant organic calendula flowers gives this tea a refreshing, tropical flavor. It can be served hot, and it's also great for iced tea. Ingredients: Fair Trade Certified Organic Black Tea*, organic calendula marigold petals, and organic compliant flavoring. *Fair Trade Certified™ by Fair Trade USA. 95% Fair Trade Certified Tea. (SW)
- 26) Nepalese Black Tea (Kosher Organic) This rare and exotic tea from the Himalayan region of Nepal is truly complex and has the flavor characteristics of both green and black tea. Because of its semi-fermented nature and the unique growing region it comes from, Nepalese Black tea produces a finish which is smooth to the taste buds, devoid of a rough edge, and the tannins do not linger. While this tea is suitable for most occasions, we have found it particularly delightful in the mornings and afternoons. Floral beginnings with a lightly tannic finish. (MR)
- 27) Nilgiri Tea (Organic) - Camellia sinensis. A dry and unassuming tea with a delightful citrusy flavor, Nilgiri makes an excellent iced tea. (SW)
- 28) Oolong- Oolong Tea undergoes partial fermentation, producing a beautiful medley of black and green teas with lightly roasted curled leaves, and it has a full-bodied, smooth taste. Low in caffeine, one cup of oolong tea has 10-15% of the caffeine in a cup of coffee. A succulent tea sure to appeal to the senses of both the black and green tea lover. (SW)

33) Peach flavored Black Tea (Organic) This Peach Flavored Tea combines a full-bodied organic black tea with organic peach pieces, infused with the natural flavor of peach. This delicious combination is an absolutely wonderful tea for preparing iced or hot. Ingredients: Organic black tea with organic peach pieces and natural peach flavor.

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34) Peppermint Chai(Organic but not certified) Black Black tea blended with spices and generally served hot or cold with milk and sweetener. Blend of Peppermint, cinnamon, cardamom, cloves, ginger and black pepper. (HB)

35) Perry's Citrus Grey (Organic Ingredients but not certified)- A house blend of Irish breakfast tea, Lemon Peels, Orange Peels, Bergamot oil, Lemon essential oil and Orange essential oil. Similar to a Lady Grey (HB)

36) Pu'erh (Kosher, Faire Trade, Organic) The black pu-erh tea Mountain Rose Herbs offers is hand harvested from wild and semi-wild broad leaf antique tea trees located in the Yunnan province of China. Pu-erh is often referred to as "cooked" due to the fact that sun-dried green tea leaves are transformed through natural fermentation from a greenish-golden color to a blackish-red tone. Over the years Pu-erh has garnered a committed following amongst tea connoisseurs who regard it as a sacred relic leftover from ancient tea cultures and traditions. Partially fermented which will appeal to the senses of both the black tea lover and the green tea lover. Deep and earthy, with light notes of smoke and moss. (MR)

37) Pu'erh (Organic) Pu-erh is a unique and unusual slightly aged tea, famed for its medicinal qualities. It is unusual because unlike other teas, it uses an accelerated fermentation process called The Wo Dui (wet-piling) process, which involves piling, dampening, and turning the tea leaves. This process ensures even fermentation. Pu-erh is the most oxidized form of tea and can mellow and improve with age like fine wine. It's distinct flavor comes from the fact that, after the leaves are picked, they are made into a sundried base tea called maocha, and then fermented. It produces a dark red liquor with a full-bodied, earthy taste.(SW)

38) Se Chung Special Oolong Tea (Organic) - Camellia sinensis. A woody astringency and the nuance of fresh peaches distinguish the remarkable aroma and flavor of this tea. Oolong is also referred to by its Chinese pinyin translation "Wu Long." (F)

39) Vanilla Black Tea (Kosher, Faire Trade, Organic) An intoxicating blend of organic vanilla, organic fair trade Assam tea from India, and organic chrysanthemum flowers. The crisp aroma and deep invigorating flavor of this tea is filled with pure vanilla bliss! Deep and invigorating with vanilla and floral tones. (MR)

40) Yunnan Tea (Organic) - Camellia sinensis. There's an exciting, slightly peppery flavor to this brisk, malty tea. It makes a wonderful breakfast tea and a tasty iced tea. (F)

The grades for whole leaf orthodox black tea are: Ceylon orange pekoe (OP) grades

- OP—Orange Pekoe: main grade, consisting of long wiry leaf without tips
 - OP1—more delicate than OP; long, wiry leaf with the light liquor
 - OPA—bolder than OP; long leaf tea which ranges from tightly wound to almost open
 - OPS—Orange Pekoe Superior: primarily from Indonesia, similar to OP
- FOP—Flowery Orange Pekoe: high-quality tea with a long leaf and few tips, considered the second grade in Assam, Dooars, and Bangladesh teas, but the first grade in China
 - FOP1: limited to only the highest quality leaves in the FOP classification
- GFOP—Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe: higher proportion of tip than FOP. Top grade in Milima and Marinyn regions, uncommon in Assam and Darjeeling
- TGFOP—Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe: the highest proportion of tip, main grade in Darjeeling and Assam
 - TGFOP1—limited to only the highest quality leaves in the TGFOP classification
- FTGFOP^{la}—Finest Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe: highest quality grade

- FTGFOP1 or STGFOP or SFTGFOP—limited to only the highest quality leaves in the FTGFOP classification

Broken leaf grades

- BT—Broken Tea: Usually a black, open, fleshy leaf that is very bulky. Classification used in Sumatra, Ceylon(Sri Lanka), and some parts of Southern India.
- BP—Broken Pekoe: Most common broken pekoe grade. From Indonesia, Ceylon(Sri Lanka), Assam and Southern India.
- BPS—Broken Pekoe Souchong: Term for broken pekoe in Assam and Darjeeling.
- FP—Flowery Pekoe: High-quality pekoe. Usually coarser with a fleshier, broken leaf. Produced in Ceylon(Sri Lanka) and Southern India, as well as in some parts of Kenya.
- BOP—Broken Orange Pekoe: Main broken grade. Prevalent in Assam, Ceylon(Sri Lanka), Southern India, Java, and China.
- F BOP—Flowery Broken Orange Pekoe: Coarser and broken with some tips. From Assam, Ceylon(Sri Lanka), Indonesia, China, and Bangladesh. In South America coarser, black broken.
- F BOP F—Finest Broken Orange Pekoe Flowery: The finest broken orange pekoe. Higher proportion of tips. Mainly from Ceylon's "low districts".
- G BOP—Golden Broken Orange Pekoe: Second grade tea with uneven leaves and few tips.
- GF BOP1—Golden Flowery Broken Orange Pekoe 1: As above, but with only the highest quality leaves in the GFBOP classification.
- TGF BOP1—Tippy Golden Flowery Broken Orange Pekoe 1: High-quality leaves with a high proportion of tips. Finest broken First Grade Leaves in Darjeeling and some parts of Assam.

GREEN AND WHITE TEAS

- 1) Angelica White (Organic but not certified) A subtle house blend of White Peony tea and Angelica Root. (HB)
- 2) Bancha Tea (Organic China/Japan) - Camellia Sinensis from China or Japan. A less costly alternative to the higher-grade Sencha, Bancha tea is more astringent and has a robust flavor. Characters: grassy, slightly dry, and medium body. (F)
- 3) Bancha Tea(Organic Japan) - Camellia sinensis from China or Japan. A less costly alternative to the higher-grade Sencha, Bancha tea is more astringent and has a robust flavor. Characters: grassy, slightly dry, and medium body. (SW)
- 4) Blueberry Green Kukicha (Organic) Enjoy this wonderful Japanese organic Karigane (green kukicha stem) tea combined with flash freeze-dried organic blueberries. Fresh fruity vegetal flavors deliver very low caffeine content in a satisfying, healthy tea that also happens to help satisfy sweet-tooth cravings. (F)
- 5) Chai Tea, Green (Organic Faire Trade) The complex, spicy sweet flavor of Chai is best appreciated on its own, although the tea also goes well with simple desserts or plain baked goods like butter cookies, brioche and croissants. (F)
- 6) China Green Tea (organic Faire Trade) - Camellia Sinensis. This everyday tea has subtle, but typical, no-nonsense green tea flavor that never overwhelms. It's good from the first cup of the morning to the last cup of the day. Try it alone or for a change of pace add lemon, mint or sugar. (F)
- 7) Chun Mee (Organic) Chunmee Green Tea (eyebrow tea) gets its name from the curve of the processed leaf. The leaves are carefully hand rolled to the shape of eye-brows and then pan-fried. The pan-fried leaves produce a highly fragrant, yellow-greenish brew with a distinctive, sweet flavor, and is known for its plum-like sweetness and smoothness. (SW)
- 8) Dragon Spice (Organic ingredients but not certified) House blend of Dragonwell Green Tea with the elegance of an herbal citrus orange. (HB)
- 9) Dragonwell (Lungching) Tea (Organic)- Camellia Sinensis This brothy, green, vegetal flavor with nuances of roasted chestnut is especially refreshing when sipped throughout the day. (F)

- 10) Earl Grey Tea, Green (Organic) - Camellia Sinensis The best known of the scented teas, its unique taste has remained popular for hundreds of years. Natural bergamot oil is sprayed on tea leaves to create a balanced citrus and tea flavor. (F)
- 11) Energy Adjustment Liven up your day with this blend of Organic Young Hyson green tea combined with eleuthero and ginkgo. It supplies your body with necessary antioxidants, while promoting a positive and greater energy. Enjoy this delightful, invigorating green tea throughout the day to support your energy and well-being. Revitalize yourself naturally! - 18) Gunpowder Tea (Organic Faire Trade) - Camellia sinensis A robust tea to pair with grilled vegetables, seafood, chicken and pork. Or try Gunpowder in small sake cups with smoked salmon or mini pot stickers at a cocktail party. (F)
- 19) Gunpowder Tea(Organic) A hearty, strong, Organic Chinese Green Tea that is rolled in small pellets and was awarded its title because of its resemblance to the pellets used for gunpowder ammunitions during the 17th century. Originally rolled tightly to preserve freshness and maintain moisture during long voyages overseas, it still holds true as an unsurpassable fresh tea that is full of dark bold color and a striking taste that is unforgettable. - 23) Indian White Tea (Organic Faire Trade) - Camellia sinensis: This special, hand-selected tea contains silvery-white unopened leaf tips. White tea is the least processed of all teas and is steamed immediately after picking to prevent any oxidation of the leaves. This particular tea is very smooth with delicate floral notes. The liquor is golden and has a light body. Truly a remarkably pleasant and drinkable tea. (F)
- 24) Jasmine Morning Breeze (Organic ingredients but not certified) A house blend of a Jasmine Green Tea, mint, dried blueberries, dried cherries, and Stevia. (HB)
- 25) Jasmine Pearls (Organic) Fine Chinese artisan organic green tea made from intact spring-harvested growing tips, (two leaves and a bud) hand rolled into a pearl-like ball that unfurls in the cup. During processing, the tea is layered with fresh jasmine blossoms. Each pearl becomes saturated with a delicious, heady fragrance that rises again from the cup during infusion. (F)
- 26) Jasmine Tea After curing, the dried green tea leaves are spread out with successive layers of fresh jasmine flowers. The tea absorbs the

exotic fragrance and yields it nicely in the cup, making this tea a sensual pleasure to drink. (F)

28) Mango Flavored Green Tea Decaffeinated (Organic Faire Trade) Lively mango aroma emanates from the peachy golden color of organic green tea. A delightful blend of organic CO2-processed decaf green tea from India, calendula petals, and mango flavor. (F)

29) Matcha (Organic Faire Trade) Matcha is a green tea produced from shade grown tea leaves and milled into a fine powder. 30) Mermaid Springs Green/White Tea (Organic ingredients but not certified) A house blend of a Tangerine White tea and the Strawberry and Raspberry Green Teas. (HB)

31) Moroccan Mint Tea (Fair Trade Organic) Ingredients: Organic Gunpowder Fair Trade tea and organic peppermint. (SW)

32) Rasmine Chai (Organic Ingredients but not certified) House blend of Jasmine and Raspberry flavored green tea, ginger, cardamom, cilantro, cinnamon granules, and fennel. (HB)

33) Sencha Tea (Organic) - Camellia sinensis Brothy, vegetal, fresh and bright, this quintessential Japanese green tea can be enjoyed all day long. It is also an excellent tea to serve guests. (F)

34) Shu Mee White Tea White Tea leaves are picked early in the season when the buds are fresh and tender, then the leaves are gently dried. White tea undergoes the least processing - the leaves are simply withered and dried. This method maintains higher levels of antioxidants,

polyphenols, and vitamins, while also yielding much less caffeine than the other tea varieties. Shu Mee White Tea brews to a light golden-red color and has a slightly sweet and delicate taste with no grassy undertones, and delivers a mellow slightly nutty taste (SW)

35) Tangerine Flavored White Tea (Organic)- Large-leafed Chinese white tea and bits of fragrant citrus peel. Clean, luscious tangerine flavor. Subtlety of white tea perfectly complemented by the tangerine. (F)

36) Thyroid Tea A house blend of kelp granules, China green tea, parsley root, and parsley root. An herbal blend to help nourish the thyroid. (HB)

37) White Peony Tea (Organic) - Camellia Sinensis this tea takes its name from its silvery, unopened buds. It has a delicate, ethereal flavor that builds on the palette with each sip. (F)

38) White Christmas White tea (Organic ingredients but not certified) A house blend of Indian White Tea, peppermint leaves, ginger root, and allspice berries. (HB)

7. Seventh Chakra House blend of peppermint leaves, chamomile flowers, kava root, and lavender flowers. (HB)
